Operation:

Spotlight & Floodlight Mode Switch: Slide the switch to select spotlight or floodlight.**Turning the light ON/OFF:** Quickly press or forward push (press and release quickly) either button to turn on the light. Press or push the switch again to turn it off.**Momentary-on:** When the light is off, press and hold any button to turn it on. Release the button to turn it off.**Mode switching:** Default is Mode 1. When the light is off, press and hold one button, then double-press and hold the other button for one second. Two slow flashes = switch to Mode 2; one slow flash = switch to Mode 1. Release the button to turn off the light.

Mode 1:

Brightness adjustment: When the light is on, double-press any button to toggle between low and high brightness. The setting will be saved for next use.**Direct high brightness:** When the light is off, double-press any button to activate high brightness.**Strobe:** To activate strobe mode, you can: (1) press and hold both buttons simultaneously, (2) press and hold one button first, then press and hold the other, or (3) quickly triple-press any button. Press any button to turn off the strobe.

Mode 2:

Direct high brightness: When the light is off, press any button to activate high brightness. Press it again to turn the light off.**Strobe:** Double-press any button to activate strobe. Press any button to turn off strobe.**Power Indicator:** When the product is on, the power indicator stays on for two seconds to show the remaining battery level. When the battery is low, the indicator remains solid red and turns off after the light is off. When the battery is drained, pressing the tail switch will light the red indicator for two seconds to signal low power.

WARNING

- Keep away from children.
- Do not store, charge, or use the product in a car or any place where the temperature may exceed 60°C.
- Do not look directly at the light source or shine in eyes, because it may cause temporary blindness or permanent damage to the eyes.
- Do not block the light at close range, the energy emitted from the light may cause the object to burn.
- **CAUTION:** Do not touch the hot surface, it may cause skin burns.

WARNING

- Do not disassemble the product.

- Do not put a hot light into any type of fabric bag or fusible plastic container.
- Do not activate the maximum brightness mode repeatedly to prevent the surface from overheating.
- If the product surface becomes too hot, switch to a lower brightness level or turn it off temporarily.
- Active thermal protection: The built-in sensor monitors the temperature in real time. After operating for a fixed period of time in high brightness, it prevents overheating by reducing the output.
- Do not immerse the flashlight in seawater or other corrosive media as it will damage the product.
- For products with magnet-sensitive switches, the brightness and mode may be inconsistent when approaching a strongly magnetic object. This is a normal phenomenon.
- When the battery is low, the maximum output will be capped at a relatively low brightness.

- The battery is non-replaceable. If damaged, please contact customer service for maintenance.
- Before long term storage, please fully charge the battery.
- Do not short-circuit the charging port with metallic objects.
- Keep the charging port clean and dry.
- It is recommended to use a USB adapter with a power of 5 W (DC5 V 1 A) or above. If the current of the adapter is lower than the max current required for charging the product, the charging time will exceed the nominal time.
- When the battery is nearly depleted, the LED output will drop to a very low brightness. This is normal. Please recharge the product in time.

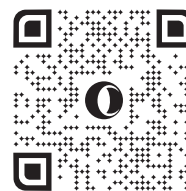
